200 km (134mi) Badlands Brevet, Ben Reifel Visitor Center (within Badlands National Park, fee required.) 13.5 hour time limit.

Access Start/Finish by traveling 75 miles East on I-90 to exit 131, then 9 miles south on Hwy 240 to Cedar Pass Lodge and Ben Reifel Visitor Center. NO SERVICES may be available, come ready to ride. The route passes through Badlands National Park, a \$5 per rider fee is required, each rider is expected to pay his/her way. this route is in very sparse and unpopulated land. Each rider should plan to be self supported or arrange their own support at checkpoints only. Roads are all paved and in generally good condition. A durable/reliable bicycles is suggested; helmet use is required. Roads are open to the public and motorized traffic is to be expected,. Follow all rules of the road. Each rider is considered to be on a solo ride. There will be no sweep of the route. Please contact RBA Tim Rangitsch at the number on Brevet Card to report an abandoned ride. | 103.4mi | | LEFT, onto Frontage Road |
| 103.6mi | | RIGHT onto Hwy 240, South to Badland's National Park |
| 111.4mi | | Enter Badlands National Park |
| 134.8mi | | Junction of 240/377, return LEFT to S/F, LEFT |
