

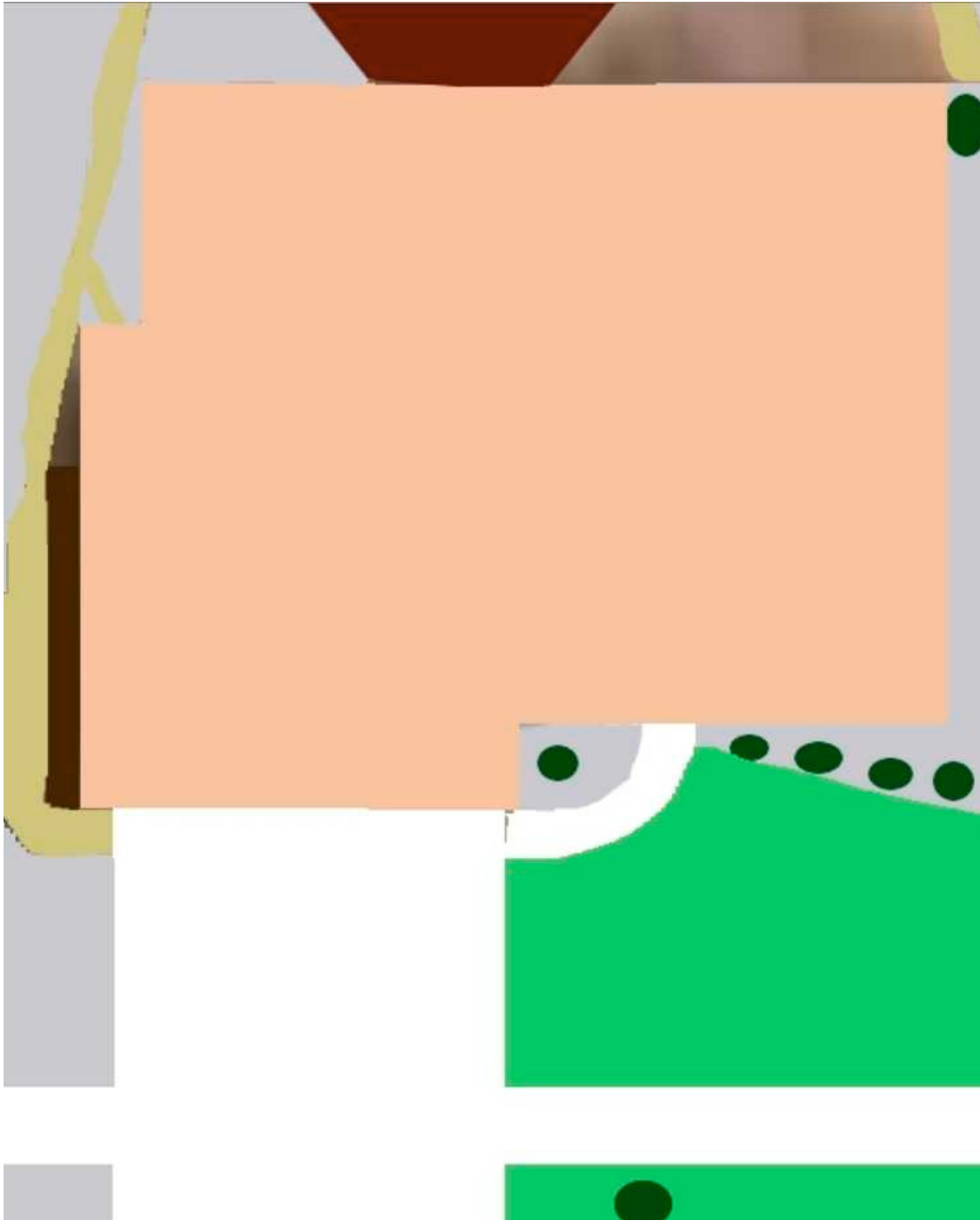

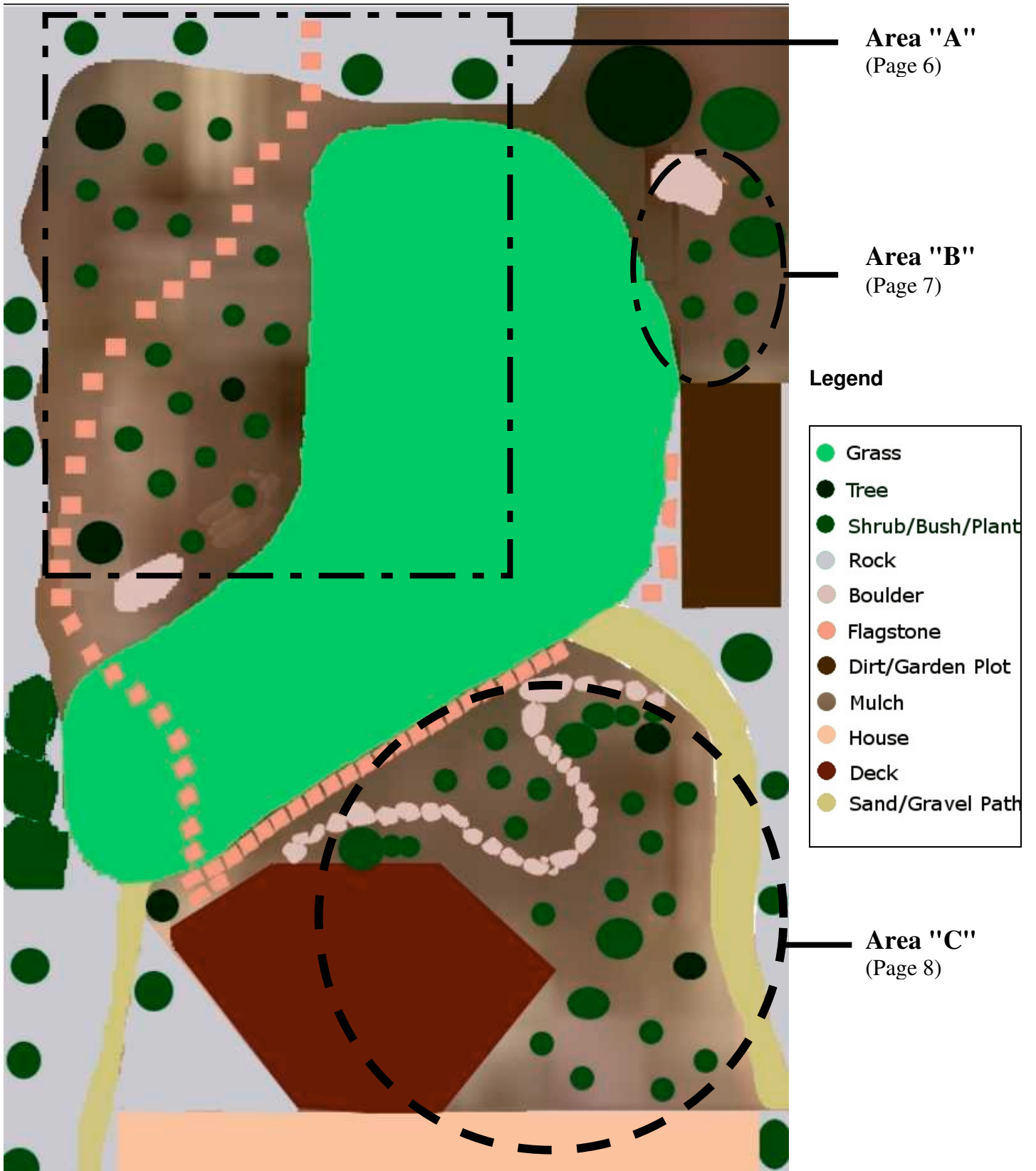
Existing Front Yard



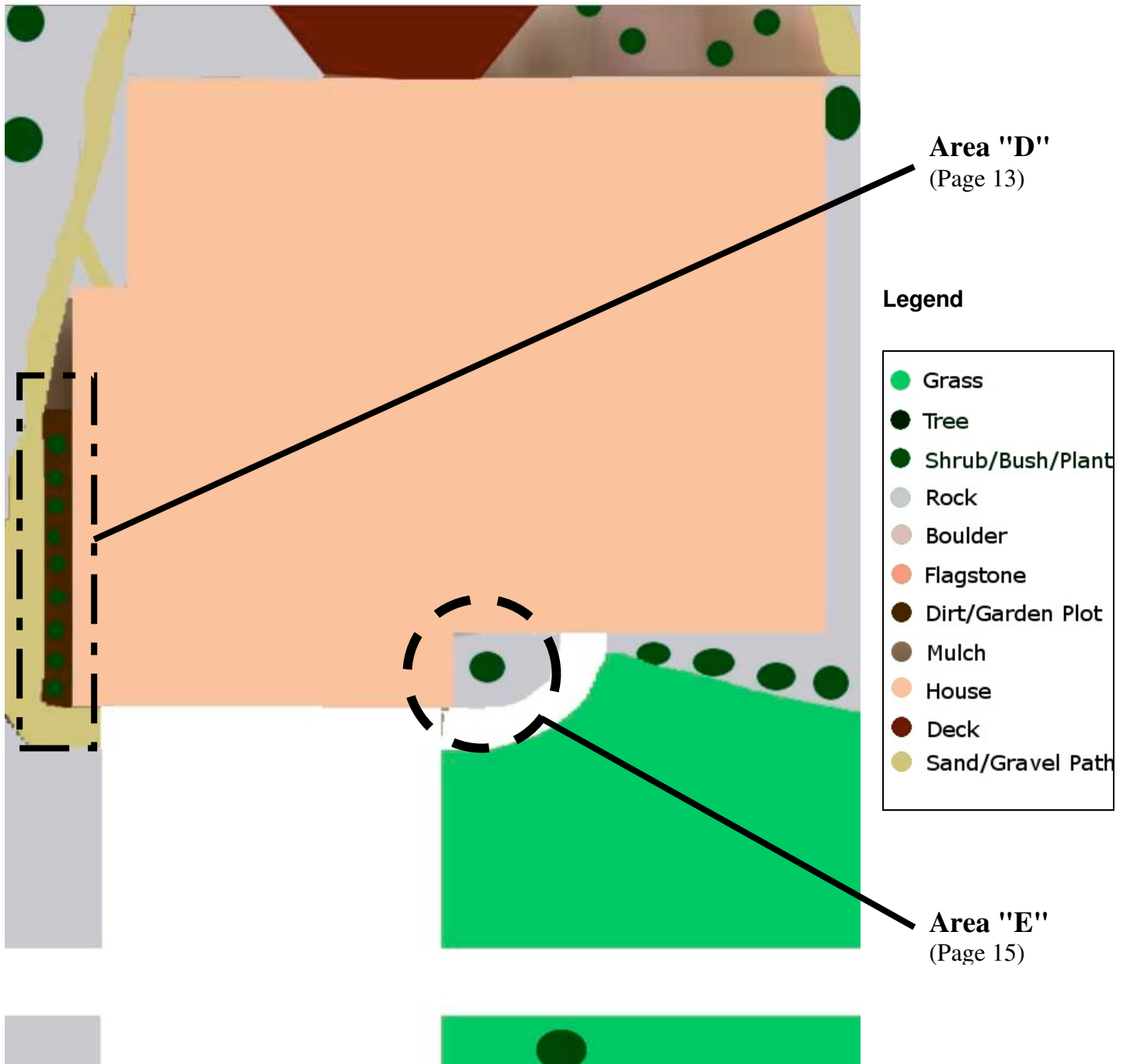

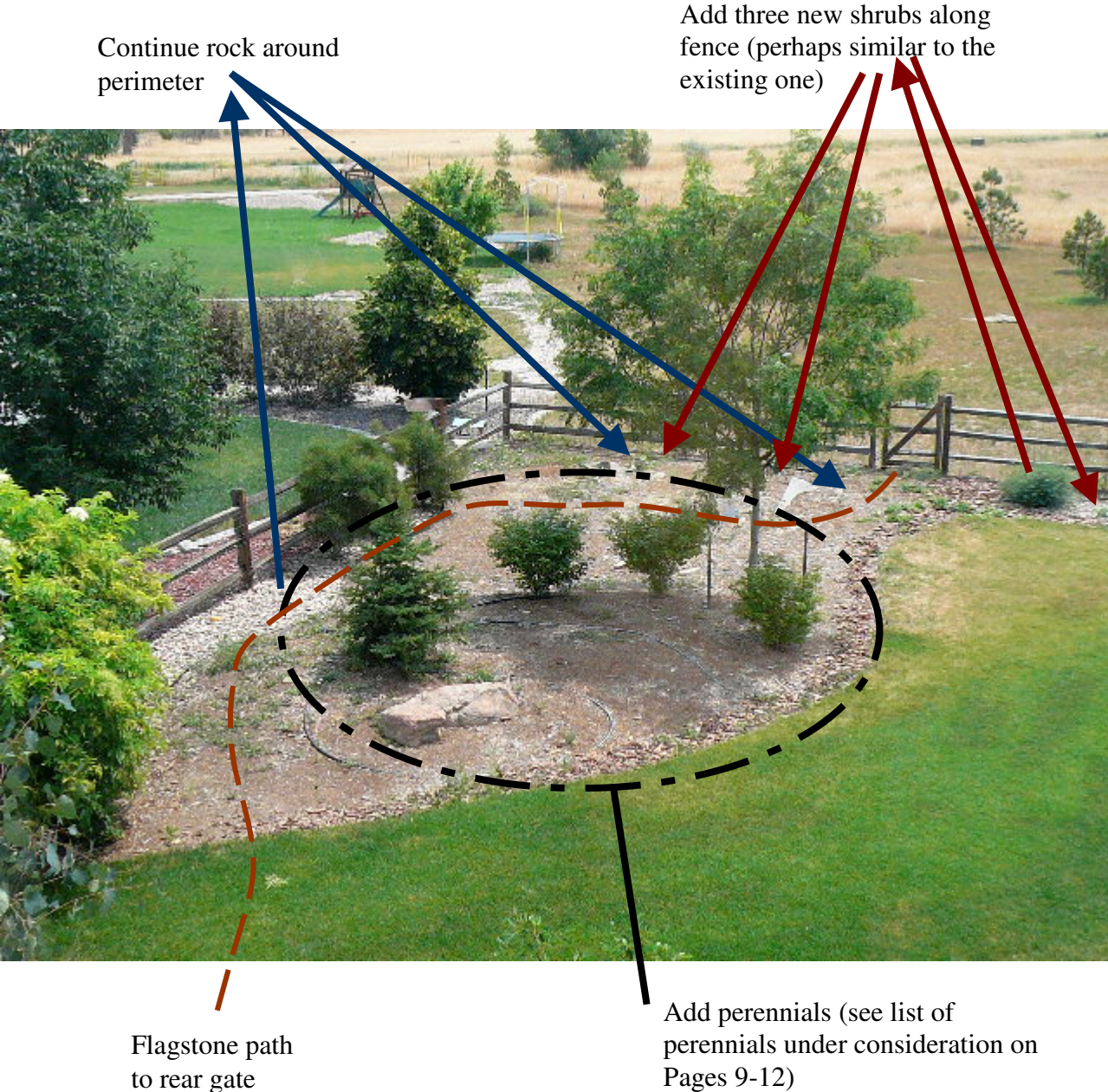


