DEATH RIDE 2002, Tour of the California Alps The RULES

- Helmets (ANSI/SNELL) are Mandatory & must be worn on head while riding.
- Obey all "Rules of the road, as printed in the California Vehicle Code Laws."
- 3. Ride single file and ride close to the edge of the road, particularly on sections open to vehicle traffic.
- 4. Be sure to come to a full stop at Woodsfords Stop Sign. If you fail to do so, you may be ticketed.
- Control downhill speed, this is not a race.
- 6. This is an UNMARKED course. Watch for hazards, cattle (open range), support vehicles and riders.
- 7. Drink fluids (2 bottles per hour) and eat plenty (especially at breakfast) before you need it.
- 8. Carry 2 water bottles (Death Ride Water Bottle is a MUST), extra tubes, patch kit, pump and tools.
- 9. Place your Death Ride numbers on clothing and blke to gain access to closed portion of course.
- 10. Be prepared for all kinds of weather-hot, cold, and wet.
- 11. No private SAGs allowed
- Please park in Proper Locations-improperly parked vehicles will be towed
- 13. ALL Riders must start no earlier than 5:30am & no later than 8:30am
- 14. COURSE CLOSURE ALL RIDERS NEED TO BE BACK AT TURTLE ROCK PARK by 8:00pm

The COURSE

START - TURTLE ROCK PARK (TRP) -

Mile 0 - Turn RIGHT on Hwy. 89.

Mile 3 - Markleeville - Watch for cross traffic

Mile 7 - Begin Hwy. 89 Road Closure (5:30am-Noon) Mile 8 - Turn LEFT on Hwy. 89 Jct. Hwy89/4

CUT OFF TIME is 9:30am.

Mile 8.1 - RIDER CHECKPOINT - MUST show

Death Ride Water Bottle & Numbers!

Mile 12 - - Monitor West WATER STOP -

Water, tech support & restroom.

Mile 17 - Top of Monitor Pass REST STOP.

Food, restrooms, & tech support.

1st PASS STICKER: One Pass Rider to lunch.

CUTOFF TIME - 10:00am to descent to Topaz.

Keep right, ride single file & Watch for Hazards.

Mile 25 - TOPAZ REST STOP - at Hwy. 395/89

Food, restrooms, & tech support.

2nd PASS STICKER. Two Pass Riders head back up. CUTOFF TIME is 11:00am.

Mile 29 - Monitor East WATER STOP --

Water & Restrooms.

Mile 33 - Top of Monitor Pass REST STOP - again.
Road Opens to traffic at Noon.

Mile 42 - STOP & Turn LEFT on to Hwy. 4 -

Mile 44 - CONCH STOP FOR 1 & 2 PASS POERS Only Centerville Flat - For restrooms, tech support (1 & 2 Pass riders return to TRP & Remember Road is Open to Traffic.)

Hwy. 4 ROAD CLOSt RE noon till 3pm.

Mile 47 - Scossa's Cow Camp REST STOP Food, restrooms, & tech support.

CUTOFF TIME is 1:00pm!

Mile 56 - Top of Ebbetts Pass REST STOP

aka Clif Bar Pass-

Food, restrooms, & tech support.

3rd PASS STICKER: 3 Pass Riders return to TRP CUTOFF TIME is 1:00pm

Mile 62 - Hermit Valley REST STOP (Clif Shot Pass)
Food, tech support & restrooms.

4th PASS STICKER. Four Pass Riders turnaround. CUT OFF TIME is 2:00pm.

Hwy. 4 opens to traffic at 3pm!

Mile 68 -- Top of Ebbett's Pass REST STOP Again.

Mile 77 - REST STOP at Scossa's Cow Camp again.
Watch left turn.

Mile 80 - LUNCH FOR 3, 4, & 5 PASS RIDERS Centerville Flat- Food & tech support. Hwy 4
opens to traffic at 3 pm.

Mile 87 - WATER - Town of Markleeville.

Mile 90 - TURTLE ROCK PARK - 4 Pass finish.

Mile 94 - Woodfords REST STOP

STOP & Cross Hwy. 88/89 - CAUTION-HEAVY & FAST TRAFFIC. FULL STOP AT JUNCTION

- Turn LEFT onto Pony Express.

CUT OFF TIME is 4:00pm.

Mile 94.5 - Turn RIGHT back on to Hwy. 88, after stopping at stop sign. Hwy. 88 is narrow & busy - Stay to right & Ride Single File.

Mile 99 - Picketts Junction REST STOP -

Food, water, & restrooms.

CUTOFF TIME IS 5:15pm.

Mile 108 - Carson Pass REST STOP -

Food, water, & restrooms.

5 PASS STICKER: You made it! Get your Ice Cream. Turn around & head back down to TRP. Control your downhill speed, stay to right, ride single file, & watch for hazards.

Mile 125 - Slow Down & Turn RIGHT Hwy. 89/4

Mile 129 - FINISH - TURTLE ROCK PARK -

CONGRATULATIONS! YOU DID IT!!!
